Due to lack of time to give history and substance, I requested of the Senate President office to have legal counsel investigate the VI code title 31 section 205, which reads "no portion of a shoreline shall be sold, leased or otherwise disposed of by the Government of the Virgin Islands" The Senate President office wrote back and advised they had no time to render a opinion on this law.
