An Act amending title 18 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 7, section 158 to increase the compensation of election officers and clerks

1 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:*

2 **SECTION 1.** Title 18 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 7, section 158 is amended as follows:

3 (a) Subsection (a) is amended--

4 (1) in paragraph 1, by striking "\$150" and inserting "250";

5 (2) in paragraph 2 by striking "\$125" and inserting "225";

6 (3) in paragraph 3 by striking "\$100" and inserting "200"; and

7 (4) in paragraph 4 by striking "\$100" and inserting "200".

8 (b) Subsection (b) is amended by striking "\$20" and inserting "\$50".

9 (c) Subsection (b) is amended by striking "\$10" and inserting "\$30".

10 **BILL SUMMARY**

11 This bill amends title 18 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 7, section 158 to increase the
12 compensation of election officers and clerks during elections, and to provide for additional
13 compensation for attendance to instructional meetings and for working after 6:00pm.
