The Committee received an update from respective officials of The Virgin Islands Research and Technology Park (RT Park) about its programs.

Mr. Peter Chapman, Chief Executive Officer of the Virgin Islands Research and Technology Park Corporation (RT Park) presented his testimony with his team that focused on the progress of seven programs initiatives and projects that have been launched or in the pipeline. RT Park Corporation is now in its 21st year and has generated approximately \$13.5 million of which twelve million was generated for financial support to the UVI and ninety per cent has been generated over the last five years. While it was noted that there was limited summer employment, RT Parks boasts of its fourteen full time employees currently on board as well as having advisers who are known as coordinators.

CEO Chapman spoke on the seven programs that included the Accelerate VI, which helps create tech startups to grow their VI business; VI STEM Kids a program designed to provide STEM learning opportunities to school age youth and to introduce basic coding concepts to motivate them to pursue further STEM studies among others such as the Tech Village; Virgin Islands STEM Talent Achieve; The Catalysts Fund Revolving Loan Program; Creativity economy and Innovate STT revitalization initiative for downtown Charlotte Amalie

BLOCK II - 1:30 p.m.

The Committee on Economic Development and Agriculture reconvened at 1:40 p.m. and received an update status from the Virgin Islands Department of Planning & Natural Resources regarding the status of operations and funding status of the Division of Fish and Wildlife to include the farming and fishing industries.

Commissioner Jean Pierre Oriol along with Dr. Nicole F. Angeli presented their testimony before the committee. Currently there are approximately 250 commercial fishers who uses thirty ports on various islands. There are over 135 charters that allow residence and tourists to explore our waters and harvest fish like mahi, wahoo and snapper. It is intended that the year 2024 for the department to upgrade fisheries related infrastructure to the maximum extent possible. Also, it was noted that repairs to Gallows Bay will be under way in the next couple of weeks as the contract was executed on June 15, 2023. The Frederiksted Fish market will also undergo redesign and reconstruction. Commissioner stated that in comparison to the other Caribbean islands, the Virgin Islands waters are highly regulated. Fishers are required to submit monthly reports and as well as spot checks are conducted from time to time.
